Ms. _____ was diagnosed with breast cancer in 1999. The original report of the estrogen and progesterone receptors from the original biopsy showed 0% staining for estrogen and 10-15% staining for progesterone. A repeat report from Mount Sinai Hospital has shown the tumour to be estrogen and progesterone receptor positive at 40% and 10% respectively.

This patient was discussed at the Physician Review Panel on February 18, 2006. Review of the patient's health record revealed that she was initially treated with Tamoxifen and currently being treated with Femara for extended adjuvant therapy. Therefore the recommendation of the panel is for no change in therapy.

We would ask that you communicate this information to your patient as soon as possible.
