

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2.7. Pathology Consolidation and Laboratory Renovations (RW)

Dr. Williams distributed a memo from Mr. Terry Gulliver, Program Director, Laboratory Program, requesting approval to proceed with the planning phases of pathology consolidation and laboratory renovations.

Agreement was reached to consolidate Pathology on one site (HSC), the benefits being improved communication and consultation process on difficult cases and improved work flow.

The redesign of St. Clare's laboratory as a core lab will free up 5,000-6,000 square feet of space which could be used to accommodate the Breast Screening Clinic and Dermatology Clinic. The consolidation of blood collection at St. Clare's would mean the closure of blood collection at the Waterford leaving that space for other uses.

Executive Team agreed in principle to implement the project and to request Facilities Management to conduct a preliminary assessment.

The potential for pathology consolidation across the region was raised. This has yet to be explored and may be discussed in the future.
