Although we are retesting your tissue sample, this does not mean your treatment will change at this time. We need to confirm the validity of your previous test results.

This is not a screening test. (Note: A lot of patients are getting this test confused with mammography.)

## How did this happen?

Due to the discovery of inconsistent results, Eastern Health has begun retesting breast cancer patients whose results indicated that they were negative for estrogen receptors. As the results of the test influences treatment, we felt it was important to make sure all the test results were accurate. That's why we are retesting all people who tested negative for ER from 1997 to August 2005.
