Hi all.

I have just reviewed her OPIS chart here is what I Just found out. This is all from Carbonear pathology reports, my speaking with pathology at Carbonear this afternoon and CaCL notes

- 1. Biopsy Sept 98 infiltrating duct carcinoma
- 2. Partial mastectomy Oct 98 margins were not clear
- 3. Simple mastectomy Oct /98
- 4. ER/PR at that time was ER Negative PR 20-25% positive.
- 5. Pty received Chemo then radiation and given that her OR was a positive she was started on Tamoxifen.
- 6. Between Nov 98-June had chemo red and started on tamoxifen in June /99.
- 7. In Nov 101 pt was referred back to her GP for continued follow up and still on Tamoxifen.
- 8. In December of 2003 had a biopsy done of chest wall with diagnosis of recurrence infiltrating duct carcinoma.
- Jan 2004 Referred to CaCl at this time and she was seen by Joy Mccarthy and in speaking with the patient she decided to request a repeat of ER/PR. Repeat was done on S1703-98 which showed ER positive 60-70% and PR positive 50-60%.- (dated 13/05/04)
- At the December 2003 appointment tamoxifen was stopped and pt was to receive Chemo in Carbonear. Hormone receptor meds were ordered following chemo ( Femara)

Dec 2003 ER/PR report on S2046-03 shows ER negative PR negative and HER2 negative.

12.

Pt had another recurrence in chest wall in November 2004 - local. Discussed at tumour board no further change in treatment needed.

13.

On November 2005 OPIS notes indicate that patient was asking about her ER/PR and DR. Zulfiquar could not find them on the computer. No results are available in PCI because they went back to Carbonear for reporting. It states that he would request repeat to those levels.

14.

Recurrence in Jan 07 - mediastinal mass. Had chemo and medications changed around.

15.

The Opis notes refer the results of ER/PR from the initial diagnosis and not of the retesting in 2004.

16.

This patient is not in the data base and was not retested when retesting of ER negative patients was set up.

That is all I have for now. I did speak with pathology dept. at Carbonear to get clarification. That is all for now. Janet

Here is what I can tell...and Janet will add in her part.....

This lady was had her original pathology done in Carbonear in 1998. With an ER of 10% she should have been identified for retesting.

Throughout her OPIS chart, her ER/PR is referred to as ER 10 Pr 20-25

In August 2007, Dr. Zulfiqar documents that her values were retested and the PR came back higher. ("repeat testing shows good PR positivity") He does not give the actual numbers and he does not comment on ER. This must have been a retest conducted through Carbonear as the results are not in meditech. This melds with the timeline Nancy gave us earlier

Janet has more information, which gives additional twists, but at this point the answer to her question are that:

she should have been identified for retesting and was not picked up by Carbonear originally or by the NLCHI review.

We were not aware of her, that is why she was not contacted.
