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

Please find enclosed reports on the above mentioned patient. As part of the ERPR review process, this patient was sent for review. She was originally diagnosed as DCIS. There was no convincing evidence of microinvasion, however I received a report from Mount Sinai dated February 6 that there was a focus of invasive ductal carcinoma. I requested slides to confirm this and after review, I sent all her slides and subsequent mastectomy slides to Bev Carter, breast pathologist in Eastern Health for a second opinion. She confirmed the Mount Sinai findings. The report from Mount Sinai is an addendum to her original left breast lump excision (SU7593-00), although the diagnosis says mastectomy which is not correct. The Eastern Health consult is an addendum to the mastectomy (SU551-01). As this is an addition to her DCIS, Dr. Jenkins and I discussed an appropriate course of action with Dr. Kara Laing. As you are the surgeon in this case, it was recommended that you discuss her clinical situation with Dr. Ganguly who was following the patient and subsequently discuss her clinical situation and the enclosed reports with your patient.
