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Ms. [REDACTED] was diagnosed with breast cancer in 2004. The original report of the estrogen and progesterone receptors from a biopsy in November 2004 showed 40% staining for estrogen and 0% staining for progesterone. A repeat report from Mount Sinai Hospital on this sample has shown the estrogen and progesterone receptor levels to be 5% and 0% respectively.

A second specimen was taken in April 2005 post mastectomy and the original report of the estrogen and progesterone receptors showed 10% staining for estrogen and 0% staining for progesterone. A repeat report from Mount Sinai Hospital on this sample has shown the estrogen and progesterone receptor levels to be 0% and 0% respectively.

This patient was discussed at the Physician Review Panel on February 16, 2006. The panel considers this patient to be hormone negative and recommend that Ms. [REDACTED] not be given further hormonal treatment for her metastatic breast cancer.

We would ask that you communicate this information to your patient as soon as possible.
