As followup to our meeting from this morning and as per your request please see below:

Challenges around requested information;

- Date specimens sent out

Not all patients have this information, to get a complete list, you may have to xreference the missing data with the original retested result from Mount Sinai. There may be 500-700 reports to review.

- Specimen # id.

All the specimen numbers currently documented in your system are the original numbers from the corresponding hospitals, all the actual results are reported in multiple manners. There are 4 internal sites, 3 application databases in St. John's alone, not all original specimen numbers may be attached to the MSH report. Also, all out of town patients were given a specimen number which is linked to the original HSC testing specimen number which is not directly linked to the original list of out of town patients.

We will hardcopy all out of town results for xreferencing..

- Pathologist original report

The HSC Referred specimen # identifies the ordering pathologists for each specimen however it will id who actually read the report. You will have to read each individual original report to determine.
