F **New Testing Results**

- Send out ER/PR for staining at an outside lab for the next few months.

- Have both sets of slides read by the same Pathologist. read in MF Sinai;
 Check comparability between states and pathologist. Check comparability between stains; and when we are satisfied, revert to processing here.

Re-testing

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- Have the negative results reviewed by pathology type and in consultation with Oncologists to see which cases should be restained and reviewed.
- These cases should follow the same procedure as outlined for #1 above.

Ask Vantana to send out one of their technical experts very soon to look at our staining technique.
