Philip C. Hébert BA MA MD PhD FCFPC

Dr Hébert is an Associate Professor in Family Medicine at Sunnybrook Health Science Centre and a member of the Joint Centre for Bioethics at the University of Toronto. Besides having his own general practice for the past 18 years, Dr Hébert acts as an ethics consultant and is chair of the Sunnybrook Research Ethics Board.

Dr Hébert has had a long-standing interest in ethics and the philosophy of medicine. He completed a PhD in philosophy in 1983 at York University and obtained his medical degree from the University of Toronto in 1984, followed by a residency in family medicine at McMaster University. Since then, he has taught professional ethics nationally and internationally on a variety number of topics to diverse groups of healthcare trainees and professionals. He has had an interest in the management of medical error for 10 years. Dr Hébert was a participant in the Canadian Adverse Events Study and is a member of the Canadian Patient Safety Initiative. He is the co-author of The *Canadian Patient Safety Dictionary* and has also co-authored papers on truth-telling in medicine and the disclosure of medical error. The second edition of his introductory book on medical ethics, "*Doing Right: A Practical Guide to Medical Ethics*" (Toronto: Oxford University Press, 1996), is to be published in the summer of 2008.
